town. He returned to his past activities and later was transferred to the United States Department of Agriculture, where he remained until the activities were abolished in October, 1932.

From 1932 thru the early forties he gained livelihood by trading securities on his own small account. This necessitated considerable study, and being visual minded he chart-portrayed all his studies. This led to accepting analytical charting assignments from others and the preparation of master-copy for reproduction by financial and statistical publishing houses, investment trusts, counsels, analysts and banks. This specialized work now keeps him fully engaged. Some of the larger copy for certain of the publishing houses is done on their premises, while the special assignment work is done in his own study and drawing room.

He married Minnie Alfreta Belding on September 11, 1940 at The Church of Covenant, Boston, Massachusetts. Mrs. Neill is of Canadian birth, English descent. Prior to her marriage she was a professional nurse. They have one child, Alfreta Belding Neill, born November 28, 1941 at Boston, Mass. Mr. and Mrs. Neill reside at 14 Medfield Street, Boston 15, Massachusetts.
