he remained until 1904 when he returned to Indiana and again became associated with D. M. Caldwell's men's store.

In 1909 he and his brother, Dr. Lynn Moorhead, succeeded the Caldwell store with a partnership known as Moorhead Brothers which continued until 1926 when a new partnership between William O. Moorhead and son, William P. Moorhead was formed. This continued until 1954 when he retired from active participation in the store.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Nova Lytle Moorhead, who died February 3, 1947. He is survived by three children, William P. Moorhead, Carol L. Moorhead and J. Reppell Moorhead, all of Indiana; by two grandchildren, and by a sister, Mrs. H. V. Smith, of Johnstown, Pa.
